1) Why was Africa's Travel Indaba postponed?

On 7th February, President Cyril Ramaphosa, announced in his state of the nation address that the national election will take place on 08 May 2019. This would have coincided with Indaba.

2) What is Africa's Travel Indaba's revised date?

Africa's Travel Indaba's has been brought forward and will now take place from 02-04 May 2019 at the Inkosi Albert Luthuli International Convention Centre in Durban.
